- MENTAL MATHS & SPELLINGS: The Year 6 children will undertake problem solving practice and calculation practice. Spellings will continue to be through the spelling detective approach whereby the children will be given the focus with some examples of words following that pattern; through the week the children will investigate and explore the pattern and will be tested on words containing that pattern on Friday. We will also continue to work on the Year 6 spelling list.
- PE: We will be having outside PE every Thursday and Friday (outdoor kit will be essential this term) but we would ask that your child has all their PE kit in school each day as the timetable can change due to the weather and other unforeseen circumstances. (PE kits should include a change of socks, especially for girls who are wearing tights!)
