Grid Method. • Place Value – count in 50&100, place value in 4-digit numbers. • Multiplication and division – multiply or divide by 4 though doubling or halving twice, by 8.

 **Reading record logs** - Please ensure your children bring in their reading record logs and reading book every day.
