Our topic for the next term is 'Animals and their habitats'. The main focus will be learning about the features of different animals e.g. mammals, nocturnal animals, animals from different parts of the world, and how they adapt and survive there.

In preparation for this topic you may choose to find out more about different animals with your child. You could do this through visiting a wildlife park, farm or zoo, watching some nature programmes together or reading some information books. We will also be looking at *The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark* by Jill Tomlinson, so you could get a copy from the library to read over the holidays.

There is also a piece of Home Learning on habitats, which we have set instead of English or Maths this week.
