World Book Day is coming up (7th March), this is always a fun time and a great way to share and enjoy reading and books.

This year our focus is 'A Magical Book Week'; the focuses are Room on The Broom, The Worst Witch and Shakespeare (especially Macbeth and the witches). We are inviting children to come to school on Friday 8th March dressed up as a book character and are suggesting that they use ideas linked to 'A Magical Book Week' (there are many ideas on the National Book Day 2019 website for easy dressing up), the children will need to bring the book linked to their outfit with them on 8th March.
