 **Reading record logs** - Please ensure your children bring in their reading record logs and reading book every day. 

 **PE** - As the weather is getting colder, tracksuits will be required for outdoor PE. Trainers would also be beneficial. 

 **Spellings**- Our spelling tests are on a Thursday and new spellings are handed out in the home learning. 

 **Timetables**- Our timetables tests are on Fridays, so we would be grateful if the children can practice these at home as well as during our maths lessons. 

 **Homework**- It is handed out on Fridays and needs to return to school by every Wednesday. 

 Could you please ensure your child has a **water bottle** in school every day. 

 Remember that your child may bring in fresh fruit and/or vegetables as a playtime snack each day, but remember that nuts must not be brought into school as we have a number of children with severe nut allergies.
